CITY OF LYONS REOPENS RENTAL FACILITIES FOR PUBLIC USE

The City of Lyons announces that the Rental Facilities at Partin Park and The Lyons Train Depot will be reopened on June 1, 2020, for limited use subject to Governor Kemp's latest Order regarding social separation to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

Throughout the COVID-19 Pandemic, citizens have been able to enjoy the use of the skate park, playgrounds, and walking trails provided they maintain at least 6 feet of separation from other persons at the park (Persons already living in the same household are not required to stay 6 feet from each other, but must separate from others in the park.)

The building facilities will once again be made available for rental by the public beginning June 1, 2020, subject to the social separation guidelines in the Governor's Order. Additionally, the recently renovated Lyons Depot has been added to the list of buildings available for rental by the public. Occupancy in the building facilities will be limited to half the normal capacity, and new social separation requirements for those attending the scheduled event must be observed at all times.
